Thank you so much for entering the Wheatstate Agility Group of Northwest Kansas (WAG) agility trial. The online volunteer sheet can be located at www.agilitydirections.com. We appreciate all our volunteers; we could not do it without you! Snacks will be provided for our fabulous volunteers.

The building will be open at 7:00 am Friday for crating, **only the event committee may set up prior to Friday at 7 am (if allowed)**. Crating may be very tight and we ask you to conserve space, including setting your chair **in front of your kennel, not beside it**. If you have difficulty finding space, please do not hesitate to ask for assistance from anyone on the trial committee. We understand a big part of an agility trial is the social aspect. Please save space for a friend using a **crate or a crate mat to save just enough space**. Do not save space with a floor mat. **Please include that person's name on the saved space**. If weather is not good and less people crate out of their cars, or more people show up on Saturday/Sunday that were not entered on Friday, we may have to ask you to snug up even more than usual in the annex. We appreciate your patience and understanding. We want everyone to have a great time and feel welcome! As always, clean up after your teammate.

There are new mats in the annex, **all crates AND chairs must be on a mat**. Please wipe your shoes and your dog's paws when coming in if it is muddy. There is a \$10 fee for any spills on the matting payable to ASDS. Crates and chairs need to be set up as they have been in the past with rows of back to back crates and chairs in front of those crates. There will be a diagram posted of where crates and chairs go to maximize space in the annex. If you have any questions, please ask a member of the trial committee.

Please be respectful of your fellow exhibitors & dogs at all times, including if your dog barks excessively and/or lunges at their kennel door. If kenneling in the annex, cover crates, put your chair in front of the kennel. If crating outside, cover crates, park away from heavy foot traffic areas around the annex & arena or position vehicle so the dog cannot see the majority of foot traffic. If barking/lunging occurs you may be asked to move or even leave the trial.

You may set up pop-up tents and E-Z ups, etc. but the facility has asked that you take them down each night. It is a safety concern due to weather. You may erect them Friday morning.

If it is raining, do not park RVs on the grass. Only RV's with reservations will be allowed to park in the parking lot.

We will be utilizing Agility Gate. The code is 1978. Maps will be available on Agility Gate and www.agilitydirections.com each morning. If you have difficulty with the [agilitydirections](http://www.agilitydirections.com) site on your phone, please scroll down and hit 'Classic' – that will give you a more mobile friendly view.

At trials there is repeated reminding to those in the arena area watching to be quiet. We know agility is a good time with friends especially those you only see at trials. Please take conversations to the hallway, warm up room, or outside especially during FAST.

For this trial, all dogs will be Small to Tall

Cynthia Blanton is not a VMO. If your dog does not have either a Temporary or Permanent Height Card they must be measured.
