Envelopes/transactions containing entries for more than the ten (10) dog maximum and/or entries received prior to the opening date shall be treated as an invalid entry and shall be returned to the sender.

- All entries must be submitted on official AKC Agility entry forms, one dog per entry form. Photocopies of entry forms without the AKC agreement are NOT acceptable. Unsigned, incomplete or illegible entries are NOT acceptable and cannot be entered in the trial (AKC Rule CH 14, Sec 4).
- Move-ups (Prior to set of trials):** Accepted until 6:00 pm, Monday, October 13, 2025 by email or by U.S. mail
- Move-ups (Day-to-Day):** KCGRC will accept day-to-day move-ups. In – class, moves from day-to-day at a set of back-to-back agility trials shall be accepted at this Trial. The request for all move-ups, including in-class moves, must be made in writing at the trial site to the Trial Secretary not later than the day preceding the event. **Please check your entries! Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed.**

A waiting list will be kept until Monday, October 12, 2026, 6:00 pm, to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of 50 entries for each day will be placed on the wait list. Any entries received by the closing date/time that are withdrawn before the waiting list deadline will be replaced by a wait listed entry if any are available. If a withdrawn entry is replaced by a wait listed entry, a full refund will be issued for the withdrawn entry. If an entry is cancelled but cannot be replaced, the exhibitor will not receive a refund and the dog will be considered absent for the trials. Any wait listed entry that does not move off the wait list into the trial by the waiting list closing date will receive a full refund.

AKC Jump Height Cards -

- You are no longer required to submit your height card with your entry.
- If a dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked indicating that the dog needs to be measured prior to running.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the course of the run.

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

- For Exhibition Only may be offered at the option of the host club. FEO will allow exhibitors to work with their dogs in a trial environment. FEO is allowed in all classes. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying.
- FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class. FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.
- Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.
- Dogs may be entered at any level (Novice, Open Excellent or Masters) in FAST, JWW, Standard or Premier classes. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.
- The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out to the scribe and the judge.
- Course time for FEO in Time 2 Beat, JWW, Standard, Premier and ISC will be 45seconds. FAST courses times for each class/height are as noted in the Regulations. Clock starts when handler leads out past the first jump.

BITCHES IN SEASON

Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial. The refund amount for bitches that come into season after closing date is the amount of the entry fee paid LESS \$5.00 per class entered. The Trial Secretary must receive written veterinarian notification by letter prior to the start of the trial. The same policy applies to injured dogs requesting a refund after the closing date.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind or deaf shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Missouri state law requires all dogs participating in dog shows be free of clinical signs of infection or contagious disease and must be vaccinated for rabies; dogs traveling from outside of the state are also required to have a certificate of veterinary inspection.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will conform to current of the *Regulations for Agility Trials*. All classes will take place indoors. Ring size will be one 98' x 100' ring.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent. A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Qualifying Ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score in each titling class. Rosettes will be awarded to 1st through 4th place dogs in each jump height in each titling class.

1st Place..... Blue
2nd Place Red
3rd Place..... Yellow

4th Place White
Qualifying Dark Green

A Rosette will be awarded to all dog/handler teams finishing a title. A jump drive with KCGRC QQ logo will be given for each QQ earned (qualifying score in both Master Standard and Master Jumpers with Weaves). A MACH Ribbon & MACH Bar will be awarded to each dog earning a MACH title and a PACH Ribbon & PACH Bar will be awarded to each dog earning a PACH title. AGCH rosette will be awarded to any dog earning the Agility Grand Championship title. A worker raffle will be held each day with a \$25.00 gas card given to the winner each day.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

- **BUILDING:** The building is climate controlled; indoor restrooms.
- **SET-UP:** No set up or saving space with mats on Thursday. Building opens at 7 am Friday morning.
- **CRATES** may be left overnight; however, the Kansas City Golden Retriever Club will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the event site. No dogs allowed overnight in the building. **No X-pens will be allowed.** Please conserve crate space and welcome our new Novice exhibitors. Crating will be tight at this site and there may be some crating in vehicles required, as well as outdoor crating under easy-ups. Please use wire crates and stack your crates whenever possible. More information about crating set-up will be included in the confirmation letter.
- **Electronic Timing:** Electronic timing will be used at these trials.
- **PARKING:** There is close parking, but please park conservatively.
- **RV PARKING:** **Overnight RV parking** is not allowed at the trial site. There are RV parks in close proximity to the show site in the Jackson County Parks System at Lake Jacomo. The Lake Jacomo campsite area is approximately 5 minutes from the trial site. Please do not contact at the last minute and expect the club to accommodate your RV as space is very limited.**
- **Exhibitors are responsible** for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

FOOD

- There will not be a concession stand on site. There are fast food restaurants and sit-down restaurants within 5 minutes of the show site.
- As usual, KCGRC will provide free individually wrapped breakfast bars, coffee and cider to exhibitors all three days. We appreciate that you choose to attend our KCGRC event. Lunch will be provided to all workers.

The site is located south of the city of Blue Springs on Highway 7, **just south of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Wyatt Rd.**

From the North (I-70): The site is 4.8 miles south of the intersection of I-70 and Hwy 7 and immediately past Anderson Rentals.

From the South: The site is 1.4 miles north of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Colbern Rd. or 5.3 miles north of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Hwy 50 and north of LockBox Storage.

In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's

responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
