NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS –

NO DOGS ARE ALLOWED IN THE FIRST ROW OF THE SEATING AREA. Due to the tight area for chairs and the number of people that are entered in these trials, we are asking that dogs are not brought into the first row of the seating areas. If you have your dog and are waiting to run, please line up in the designated areas or in the hall. Your cooperation is greatly appreciated.

FYI-

There is ongoing construction at the I-70/ I-435 interchange. MoDot will be closing exits and posting detours. You may need to allow extra time for traffic delays due to this construction. In addition, there are “rolling pot hole repairs” going on through Kansas City so be aware and drive safely.

Trial Information

Trial Hours are 7:00 am to 30 minutes after the completion of the trials.

Ring size: 98' X 100'

The building is climate controlled.

Tarps or crate mats must be completely under crates and chairs.

Flexi-leads will not be allowed in the building.

No electrical devices will be allowed. Battery operated fans are welcome.

Dogs may not be left in the building overnight.

Please bring crates, water and clean up after your dogs

- The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. Therefore, no Flexi-leads are allowed inside or within 50 ft of the building. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.
- Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competitions by action of the Event Committee.
- Entry fees will not be refunded if the trials cannot be opened or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbance, fire, and act of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Event Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.
- Bitches in season are not allowed to compete in AKC Agility Trials. Refunds for bitches that come in season and injured dogs after the closing date, will receive a refund minus \$10.00 per day with a veterinary statement.
- All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.
- No Flexi-leads allowed in the building or within 50 ft of the building.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee.
- No refunds will be issued for overpayment of less than \$10.
- Checks for canceled entries will be shredded; no check will be returned.
- Owners are responsible for errors in making our entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.
- Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. Failure to be at ring gate could result in the exhibitor being marked absent.
- Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must enter their JH# and complete back of form. Include only AKC title on entries.
- Dogs under 4 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.
- Exhibitors may wear shirts or insignia of their training group if they wish.
- Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.
- Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of the requirement.
- Electronic timing will be used at these trials.

Move-ups

For the Friday trial: MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CST, Monday, March 25, 2019.

Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

For the Saturday and Sunday trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday and Saturday, respectively and must be submitted at the trial.

Directions

Please be aware that most navigation devices do not know the location for All Star Dog Sports! It is advised that you look at a map and find the location before trusting your phone or GPS.

The site is located south of the city of Blue Springs on Highway 7., just south of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Wyatt Rd on the west side of Hwy 7.

If you are coming from the north(I-70), it is 4.8 miles south of the intersection of Hwy 7 and I-70 immediately past Anderson Rentals.

If you are coming from the South, it is 1.4 miles north of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Colbern Rd or 5.3 miles north of the intersection of Hwy 7 and Hwy 50, north of LockBox Storage.

Hwy 7 is divided by a median so it will be necessary to drive north of the site and make a U-turn at Wyatt. Rd.
